Habitat for Humanity Calgary builds simple, decent and affordable homes in partnership with the community and with the families who will own them.

Homes are built almost completely by volunteers using building materials, land and money donated by individuals, businesses, service clubs, foundations, and faith communities.

Criteria

Families must:

- Have children that will benefit from a decent and affordable home.
- Applicants must be employed but earning below low-income level.
- The low-income cut-offs are:
 - 2 persons \$32,400
 - 3 persons \$38,400
 - 4 persons \$43,800
 - 5 persons \$49,200
 - 6 persons \$54,600
 - 7 + persons \$58,800
- Applicants must be able to pay a no-interest, no down payment mortgage
- Live in Calgary
- Be willing to help build own home, others homes, and contribute to other programs (sweat equity)
- Accept responsibilities of homeownership (Insurance, taxes, utilities, etc.)
- Attend information sessions

All applications are reviewed and those who qualify and are most in need are selected. They do not maintain a waiting list therefore if a family is not selected they are encouraged to apply again the following year.
